

Fall Plumbing Checklist

 Visual inspection of exposed pipes in the basement, crawl space, attic, garage, and mechanical rooms
 Install pipe insulation: foam sleeves, fiberglass wraps, or heat tape
 Discontent hoses from outdoor faucets.
 Make sure to have frost-free hose bibs installed or anti-siphon faucets.
Otherwise, install faucet covers over the outdoor water spigots.
 Keep an eye out for drops in water pressure ; it <u>could</u> be a sign of frozen or busted pipes.
 Remember to drip faucets and open under-cabinet doors when outdoor temperatures drop below 20 degrees Fahrenheit (F).
 Clean out the sump pump.
 Set the indoor thermostat above 60 degrees F.
 Confirm the water heater temperature setting is at least 120 degrees F for efficiency.
 Schedule an annual inspection with Clement's Plumbing, Heating, and Air in late September of your home's water heater and furnace between October and November.
 Finally, Test if your home's main shut-off valve is functioning correctly in case there are any emergencies.
